

Frequently Asked Questions and Frequently Given Answers

1. **Question:** I downloaded MATGPR_R3, but I cannot run the program because there is no matgpr.m file in the distribution bundle.

Answer: Please try to learn more about MATLAB. And please do not ask for the source code as a remedy to your problem. It doesn't work this way!

2. **Question:** Unfortunately, the program does not run in my Matlab 7.x. When I start by **double-clicking matGPR.p** I get an error message.

Answer: Again, please try to learn more about MATLAB. And please do not ask for the source code as a remedy to your problem. It doesn't work this way!

3. **Question:** I tried to run matgpr.p but it returned an error message saying,

???Error: File: margpr.p Line: 90 Column: 0
Expression or statement is incomplete or incorrect.

Answer: The error is generated by out-dated or incomplete or pirated/incomplete MATLAB installations. Please check! And please do not ask for the source code as a remedy to your problem. It doesn't work this way!

4. **Question:** You did not answer my request for matGPR R3.5

Answer: Please note that matGPR R3.5 is not freely distributed software, and I reserve the right to distribute it at my discretion. There are some stipulations as to its availability, which are plainly laid in the matGPR Home Page. Please consider them carefully, particularly those printed in bold. If you do not consent to the stipulations, you can always download and use matGPR 3.1.
