The 23 chapters of the book are available as separate articles at these addresses. In fact, articles about Tanagras are still regularly published under the same Facebook and Academia addresses. The two most recent articles discuss the background of Tanagras' family and also present an in-depth analysis of the telekinetic phenomena of his medium Cleio.

The additional bonus material that I have made available on the Internet about the historical information mentioned above is intended to improve the quality of reading, instead of directly from the pages of a book. In this way reading from their digital form on a computer screen, one can better inspect the often very old faded photos of the book, as their quality is improved in terms of brightness and details.
