General Congress Schedule

The Congress will start early Tuesday evening, July 11th with the Opening Ceremony and Reception Dinner. Four full days (Wednesday 12th to Saturday 15th) of scientific and social activities will follow. The IACCP General Assembly will be held on Friday afternoon and the Farewell Dinner will follow in the evening. Other Social events will be announced in due course. Pre-Congress scientific activities will be held on Monday 10th and Tuesday 11th of July.

Please note that the 18th IACCP Congress is followed by the 26th ICAP Congress to be held in Athens, from the 16th to the 21st of July, 2006.

General Guidelines for Submission of Abstracts

ALL ABSTRACTS MUST BE SUBMITTED ELECTRONICALLY THROUGH

The Congress will include Symposia, Poster Sessions, Poster Symposia, Individual Presentations in Thematic Sessions and Workshops.

Participants are limited to two (2) presentations- as presenting authors in Sessions or of Posters. This does not apply to chairing sessions or to non-presenting authorships.

Symposia

A Convenor will organize each Symposium and chair it. Symposia are allocated 11/2 hours, with 4 presentations of up to 20 minutes each, including questions, followed by a Discussant presentation or general discussion of 10 minutes. Double Symposia (3 hour sessions), for 8 presentations on a topic, are also possible.

Poster Presentations

Posters will be grouped thematically and displayed for 2-3 hours. Posters should be readable from $1\frac{1}{2}$ metres away; maximum dimensions: 100cm high \times 80cm wide.

Poster Symposia (The dimensions of Posters are the same as in Poster Presentations)

To increase in-depth intellectual exchange, we offer a new option, 1½ hour poster symposia. Convenors will organize these symposia like regular symposia, including 5-6 presenters who prepare posters on a related topic. The Convenor will introduce the symposium, attendees will then study the posters for 30 minutes, presenters will each speak for 5 minutes about points they wish to emphasize and/or on which they seek reactions. The Convenor will then lead a 25-30 minute discussion.

Individual Presentations in Thematic Sessions

Individual Presentations will be grouped into 11/2 hour Thematic Sessions including 5 presentations with a duration of 15 minutes each, including time for questions.

Workshop Sessions

Workshops will last approximately 11/2 hours each.

December 16, 2005: Deadline for submitting Proposals for Poster and Individual Presentations

February 6, 2006: Notification on Symposia, Poster Symposia and Workshops

February 20, 2006: Notification on Posters and Individual Presentations

The PRESENTING author's registration fee must have been received by May 22nd, 2006 for the abstract to appear in the Congress Abstract book.

Awards

IACCP members may apply for a Witkin/Okonji Award to facilitate attendance at the congress. These awards honour Herman Witkin and Michael Ogbulu Okonji, pioneers in the field of collaborative cross-cultural research. Awards are intended for members from areas of the world that would otherwise not be represented at the congress. Applications are judged on scientific contribution to the congress, geographic area, relative need, and applicant's status. Preference is given to young professionals and advanced graduate students. Awards are usually no more than US\$500.
